

Supplementary terms and conditions of purchasing for technical systems/equipment

1. Duty to perform "according to the state of the art and considering the relevant laws, regulations and conditions, in particular considering the labor protection law, ordinance on Industrial safety and health, also the equipment and Product Safety Act GPSG as well as their regulations and technical rules. Accordingly all EG-directives, especially directives 98/37 EC (machinery directive) 73/23 EEC (low voltage directive) and 89/336 EEC (EMC directive). "
2. "The contractor has to ensure that technical systems/equipment do not consume more energy than it is required for their intended use. For the execution/implementation of technical systems/equipment it is necessary to use the most energy-efficient drives, motors and other active components. The total energy requirement of the technical systems/equipment has to be comparable to a reference installation of the same type and size/capacity. Furthermore it is not allowed to exceed the energy requirement of the reference installation."
3. The rated power of technical systems/equipment has to be defined according to the power, which is required for their intended use. The power has to ensure the intended use but should not be excessively oversized. Specifications for the rated power of technical systems/equipment are determined by the requester (intended user)."
4. "The contractor has to inform the purchaser about the essential expert/special handling, necessary maintenance and repair measures, inspections that are required for proper use and trouble-free use. Also to provide with corresponding documents, eg. maintenance instructions."
